Students may work as partners. Must have their own campaign posters (President and Vice President) No more than groups of 2

## **Global Warming Project Check List:**

- 1. Create a digital presentation to support your final campaign speech to <u>clearly</u> <u>present</u> your plans to solve this problem. (powerpoint, prezi, etc.)
- 2. Explain what global warming is and why it is happening (or not happening):
  - a. Include Data/Tables/Charts/Pictures
- 3. Explain how global warming is impacting different regions of the earth (give specific examples):
  - a. Animals, Plants, Humans, Ecosystems:
- 4. Create your proposal as president:
  - a. How will you reduce global warming/climate change?
  - b. What energy sources are you converting to?
  - c. How will you and the American people pay for this?
  - d. What changes will "we the people" see if we vote to approve your proposal?
  - e. Will you have other countries involved? Meetings or councils?
- 5. Prepare for a debate to <u>present</u> your ideas of how to solve this problem and be ready to answer questions from potential voters.
- 6. Lastly, create your campaign poster. Show us how your plan in an illustration or explanation. Persuade the people to vote for you and your plan.
